The attached chart indicates the new organizational make-up of 601. The major change is the discontinuance of the Intelligence Analysis Division, with its functions of studying PCR/PST/PO, etc., being taken over by two new divisions. The other change of major importance is the combining of division responsibility and the creation of two new divisions to study political parties and exterior activities.

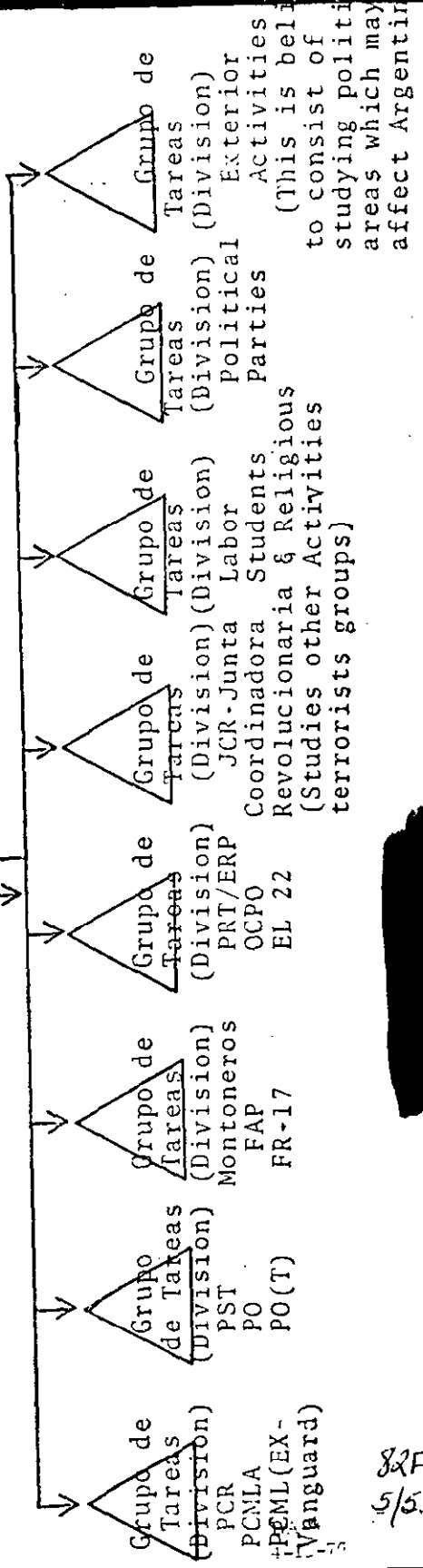
ORGANIZATIONAL CHART OF "601"
